### Part A: Fix the Sentence

Each sentence has an error. Rewrite it correctly on the line.

1. Fix the sentence: *The fraction  $1/2$  is equivalent to  $2/3$  because both are close to one half.*

Rewrite: **The fraction  $1/2$  is equivalent to  $2/4$  because both show the same amount of the whole.**

2. Fix the sentence: *To check if  $2/4$  equals  $1/2$ , just compare the top numbers.*

Rewrite: **To check if  $2/4$  equals  $1/2$ , compare the size of the shaded part of the whole.**
