Affect is usually a verb meaning to influence, while effect is usually a noun meaning a result. For example: Rain can affect our recess plans. The effect of studying is a better Grade 4 test score.

2. Why is it important for Grade 4 writers to know the difference between accept and except?

Accept means to receive or agree to something, but except means to leave out or exclude. Grade 4 writers must choose carefully so readers know whether someone is included or excluded from a group or idea.
